- I. **Chairman Rick Van Dyken called to order the decision meeting of the Broadwater Conservation District at 9:02 am.**

- II. **BW-13-20 Decision**
 - a. BW-13-20 – Steven McCullough, Jefferson River – Boat Ramp – The board discussed the permit. Darrell and Ron completed an inspection on September 28th, 2020. Ron and Darrell both felt that excavating a boat ramp at this location was best done at current low flow. Waiting until late October will make the process harder. Darrell mentioned that this was a good spot for a boat ramp. It already has a natural rock barb and it is not a real steep bank. Kelly Ingalls made a motion to approve BW-13-20 with the modifications to secure the open cut with natural rock and excavated material must be disposed away from the stream. Since current flow is 1,000 cfs below normal and will allow for less disturbance, work on the project must start as soon as possible. Darrell Baum seconded the motion. Motion passed.
